






Edith Budge has performed in several jazz festivals around the country, at the Caveau de la Huchette in Paris, London's Dolphin Square and just recently completed a three and a half years residency at the Balmoral Hotel in Edinburgh. In February of this year, on a visit to New York, Edith was invited to sing with a crowd of

world class musicians, including; singer Carol Sudhalter, Joe Tranchina (Piano) Leonard Gaskin (Bass) and Jimmy Butts (Drums). The session was an outstanding success and prompted Carol Sudhalter to extend an invitation to Edith to join her on tour later in the year. Edith has also been asked to work in New York but has yet to make a decision.





In May of 2004, the Edith Budge Trio performed, before a select audience, a concert of gospel and Jazz at the Palace of Holyrood. She is currently recording a CD, due to be released in the summer of 2004, of songs to celebrate the centenary year of the great.


Off the Wall 2004
