## Bar positions for the King's Theatre, Edinburgh - "HMS Pinafore" & "Patience" March 2009

v1-7R. (4-March-09)

The positions tabulated below are distances from the setting line on the stage, in line with the rear of the proscenium arch (not allowing for tabs). Between D and 1 is the bridge overstage, 12 inches wide centred at 4 feet 6 upstage, so the only bar in that area is a seldom-used bar under the bridge, roped from the PS fly floor - All other bars controlled from the OP fly floor.

Bars 11 and 34 marked (\*) fly out only to half height and are commonly used for "Elex" only. Elex Bars are all preliminary at present!

Pinafore – 4 ropes from Grid for climbing about Bar 20, across centre of stage as before.

KT Black Legs will not be used when satisfactory masking is provided by the wing flats in Patience – entrance width still to be assessed with director in theatre against speed/volume of cast, some sizes may still alter dependent on production requirements, on advice of Artistic Director. <sup>+</sup> The full black with the portraits is only fully in at the start of Pinafore Act I, it flies out to its upper dead and becomes a border there for both shows.
