Getting There

Metro

All tour sites are accessible via the **PURPLE** line between the Wilshire/Western and Wilshire/Vermont Metro stops.

An unlimited day pass is \$7.00 and a one-way ticket is \$1.75. You must purchase a \$1.00 refillable TAP card to ride the Metro rail.

Bus

Tour route is accessible via the **20** or **720** bus. Bus stops are available about every block along Wilshire Blvd.

Bus is \$1.75 one-way. Cash or TAP card is accepted.

Parking

Metered street parking is available along Wilshire Blvd. and side streets. Please pay attention to street signs.

Look For...

Look for these hidden details along the tour route!



Don't miss this original Art Deco beam peeking through a tiled column at the **Wilshire Professional Building**.

Look closely at this sign near the **Normandie Club** at **Hotel Normandie** to see signs from the past. Does it say liquor or market?



Check out this walk of fame star for the Son of God in front of the **Oasis Church**.



Find what remains of the iconic **Ambassador Hotel** near the entrance to the **Robert F. Kennedy Community Schools**.
