SCIENTISTS WILL SPEAK ON PEACE Einstein, Millikan and

Beard on Program to Be Sponsored by Colleges Prof. Albert Einstein, Dr. Robert

A. Millikan and Dr. Charles A. Beard have been procured, it was announced yesterday, as the chief speakers on a "Program in the Interest of Public Opinion," which will be conducted under the auspices of

the student bodies of eleven Southern California colleges and universities on the evening of the 27th inst. at the Pasadena Civic Audi-

torium. The event, which will be in the nature of a student mass meeting, is designed to give the youth of Southern California a comprehen-

sive view of the problems of the day, especially those concerned with international relations, peace and good government. A fifteen-

minute portion of the program will be broadcast by station KHJ over a Pacific Coast hook-up. Laramee Haynes of Occidental College, president of the Southern California College Student Body Presidents' Association, will preside. Dean McHenry, student body president at the University of California at Los Angeles, will represent the

students' viewpoint in an address on the topic, "The American Student and World Peace." Dr. Einstein's topic will be "Public Opinion," that of Dr. Millikan will be "The Conditions of Peace," and Dr. Beard will speak on "National Policy and Armaments."
